Often, this project will grow out of Chc/Lat 102W (Research Seminar). Methods and analytical frameworks vary depending on the student and faculty advisors. Interested students should enroll in Chc/Lat 199.</p> <p>All courses for the major must be taken <b>for a letter grade option</b>.
