GPA of 2.0 in their major and in the up-div courses for the major. <u>Cumulative GPA also must be 2.00 or above.</u></p> <p>Residency Requirement: At least 36 of the final 45 units completed by a student for the bachelor's degree must be earned in residence at the UCI campus.
